You accept and agree to the following terms and conditions for Your present and future Contributions to software distributed via elstel.org. In return, the authors of elstel.org shall use your contributions in public interest. Except for the license granted herein You reserve all right, title and interest in and to Your Contributions.

1. Definitions. “You” (or “Your”) shall mean the copyright owner or legal entity authorized by the copyright owner that is making this Agreement with the authors of elstel.org. For legal entities, the entity making a Contribution and all other entities that control, are controlled by, or are under common control with that entity are considered to be a single Contributor. For the purposes of this declaration, “control” means (i) the power, direct or indirect, to cause the direction or management of such entity, whether by contract or otherwise, or (ii) ownership of fifty percent (50%) or more of the outstanding shares, or (iii) beneficial ownership of such entity.

“Contribution” shall mean any original work of authorship, including any modifications or additions to an existing work, that is submitted by You on top of any products owned or managed by the authors of elstel.org. For the purpose of this definition “submitted” means any form of electronic, verbal or written communication that is either communicated to the authors of elstel.org or becomes publicly available.

2. Grant of Copyright License. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, You hereby grant to the initial authors of the given piece of software that you have modified or extended and that is available via elstel.org a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, no-charge, royalty-free, irrevocable copyright license to reproduce, prepare derivative works of, publicly display, publicly perform, re-license and distribute Your Contributions and such derivative works. The authors of the first version of a given piece of software distributed via elstel.org are herein referred to as the initial authors.

3. Grant of Patent License. Subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement, You hereby grant to the initial authors a perpetual, worldwide, non-exclusive, no-charge, royalty-free, irrevocable (except as stands in this section) patent license to make, have made, use, offer to sell, sell, import, and otherwise transfer the Work, where such license applies only to those patent claims licensable by You that are necessarily infringed by Your Contribution(s) alone or by combination of Your Contribution(s) with the Work to which such Contribution(s) was submitted. If any entity institutes patent litigation against You or any other entity that your Contribution, or the Work to which you have contributed, constitutes direct or contributory patent infringement then any patent licenses granted to that entity under this Agreement for that Contribution or Work shall terminate as of the date such litigation is filed.

4. You represent that you are legally entitled to grant the above license. If your employer(s) has rights to intellectual property that you create that includes your Contributions, you represent that you have received permission to make Contributions on behalf of that employer, that your employer has waived such rights for your Contributions to software from elstel.org or that your employer has executed a separate Corporate CLA with the authors of elstel.org.

5. You represent that each of Your Contributions is Your original creation (see section 7 for submissions on behalf of others). You represent that Your Contribution submissions include complete details of any third-party license or other restriction (including but not limited to, related patents and trademarks) of which you are personally aware and which are associated with any part of Your Contributions.

6. You are not expected to provide support for Your Contributions, except to the extent You desire to provide support. You may provide support for free, for a fee, or not at all. Unless required by applicable law or agreed to in writing, You provide Your Contributions on an “AS IS” BASIS, WITHOUT WARRANTIES OR CONDITIONS OF ANY KIND, either express or implied, including without limitation, any warranties or conditions of TITLE, NON-INFRINGEMENT, MERCHANTABILITY, or FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

7. Should you wish to submit work that is not Your original creation, You may submit it to the conspicuity of the authors of elstel.org identifying the complete details of its source and of any license or other restriction (including, but not limited to, related patents, trademarks, and license agreements) of which you are personally aware, and conspicuously marking the work as “Submitted on behalf of a third-party: [named here]”.
